

BioMalaysia sees participation from 160 exhibitors

Johor: BioMalaysia, which is the flagship biotechnology event of Malaysia, kicked off in Johor on October 21, 2013. The three-day event focused on converging ideas and provided opportunities to scientists, researchers and biotechnology companies.
