

India signs MoU with Chinese medical zone

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At the recently held BioAsia 2019 event, Asia's largest Biotechnology and Life-sciences forum and the annual flagship event of the Government of Telangana in India, an MoU was signed between the Government of Telangana, India and Taizhou Medical Hi-Tech Development Zone (Taizhou Zone) supported by the Government of Taizhou, China.
