

Singapore to deliver primary healthcare to migrant workers

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WellAway e-pharmacy partners SATA CommHealth to deliver primary healthcare to Singapore's migrant workers



DocMed Technology, a subsidiary of SGX Catalist-listed Hyphens Pharma International Limited, has signed a partnership agreement with SATA CommHealth, one of four Anchor Operators appointed by Singapore's Ministry of Manpower under its Primary Care Plan, to deliver a new primary healthcare system for migrant workers starting on 1 April 2022.

Under the Partnership, DocMed's WellAway e-pharmacy will provide e-pharmacy medication delivery to the migrant worker patient after a teleconsultation by SATA CommHealth. To ensure integrity of the medications, a team of professional pharmacists and pharmacy technicians supplies the medications in accordance with Singapore Standards.
