This development will expand the existing infrastructure to accommodate both production and logistics activities. The state-of-the-art facility will operate at temperatures ranging from -25°C to -15°C and will include a dedicated secondary production room with frozen conditions, further enhancing Almac's capabilities in managing temperature-sensitive clinical supplies.
