

UAE government to streamline health facility licensing in Sharjah

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MoU inked to drive digital transformation across all transactions related to health facility licensing in Sharjah



The Ministry of Health and Prevention (MoHAP) and the Sharjah Economic Development Department (SEDD) have teamed up by signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

The strategic partnership aims to establish an electronic link to streamline the licensing processes for health facilities in Sharjah, enhancing regulatory services by embracing best practices in digital transformation in line with government directives.
