Dedicated to improving lives, NephroPlus prioritises patient comfort through personalised care and flexible treatment options, redefining kidney care in Karnataka with innovation and compassion, one dialysis session at a time."

The company was established 15 years back with a vision to enable people on dialysis across the world to lead long, happy, and productive lives. The company treats ~32,000 patients per month.
