

WuXi concludes 2013 Life Science Awards in Beijing

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Singapore: WuXi PharmaTech, a leading pharmaceutical, biotechnology and medical device R&D outsourcing company with operations in China and the US, has concluded its seventh annual WuXi PharmaTech Life Science and Chemistry Awards in Beijing.

Established in 2007, the WuXi PharmaTech Life Science and Chemistry Awards are the first nationwide scientific awards in China established by a life science enterprise.

The awards aim to foster early innovation and to encourage pursuit of excellence in life science research. Participants were
