

BioTaiwan 2014 to be held in Taipei

Singapore: BioTaiwan 2014 the major venue for promoting regional strengths and opportunities in biotech, is all set to be held in Taipei, from July 23-27, hosted by the Taiwan Bio Industry Organization (TBIO).
