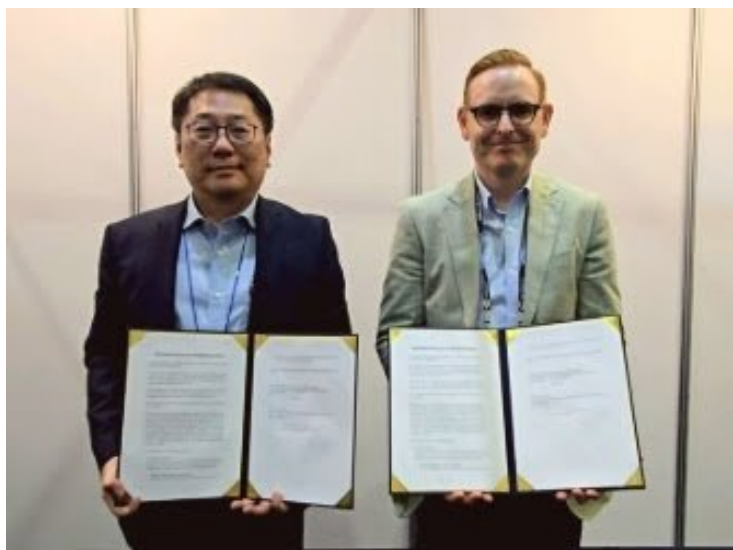


TFBS Bioscience and QIMR Berghofer sign MoU to advance global CGT collaboration
